Indriya and Krishna taught the children a traditional dance called the dandiya rasa, which included ceremonial sticks, and they shared some meditation and devotional chanting (kirtan) with the children. The children's behaviour was exemplary and they thoroughly enjoyed their morning. It was great to see such enthusiasm for all the different activities, which really brought their learning to life.
